

Information about Integrated Personal Commissioning (IPC)



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- The **Five Year Forward View** “Patients will gain far greater control of their health own care –through the option of a shared health and social care budget.”
- **Integrated Personal Commissioning:** On 4th July 2014, at the Local Government Association Conference, Simon Stevens set out plans for a new Integrated Personal Commissioning (IPC) programme, to blend comprehensive health and social care funding for individuals, and allow them to direct how it is used.

Who for?

- **Children and young people** with complex needs, including those eligible for education, health and care plans.
- People with **multiple long-term conditions**, particularly older people with frailty.
- People with **learning disabilities** with high support needs, including those who are in institutional settings or at risk of being placed in these settings.
- People with significant **mental health** needs, such as those eligible for the Care Programme Approach or those who use high levels of unplanned care.

To achieve what?

- **People with complex needs and their carers have better quality of life and can achieve the outcomes that are important to them and their families** through greater involvement in their care, and being able to design support around their needs and circumstances.
- **Prevention of crises in people's lives that lead to unplanned hospital and institutional care** by keeping them well and supporting self-management as measured by tools such as 'patient activation' – so ensuring better value for money.
- **Better integration and quality of care**, including better user and family experience of care.

A **proactive approach** to improving your experience of care and preventing crises

A **different conversation** with the people involved in your care focussed on what's important to you

A **shift in control** over the resources available to you, your carers and family

A **community and peer focus** to build your knowledge, confidence, and connections

A **wider range of care and support options** tailored to your needs and preferences

IPC and Transforming Care

- Building the right support (30 October): new service model and transformation plan in response to Winterbourne View
- Children and adults with learning disabilities or autism
- Person-centred care and choice and control are at the core - personal budgets across health and social care
- We are looking for partners who can:
 - Support IPC sites to deliver and bring in learning from other areas
 - Help us engage with all areas of England to develop their plans
 - Bring specific expertise in this area

In Control and IPC

- Over next two years....

 - Work on integrated personal budgets and joint commissioning
 - A whole life POET
 - Community leadership
 - All Together Better
 - Regional Children's events (with CDC)

What does this mean for you?

- For people of all ages with long term conditions this will be the standard model of delivery everywhere by 2020
- We will be sharing all the work we are involved in and there will be opportunities to test certain and get involved – for example we are already starting to test the integrated personal budgets framework which is based around the ‘quadrants’
- From 2017 the IPC approach will start being rolled out.....hopefully by then we will have been able to help you all think through what this means for you at home and at work
